### Research Impact Plan Template

#### PURPOSE STATEMENT

Aim for about three sentences. Make sure to link your project's goals with specific societal or community-based goals. Try to briefly answer each of these questions in your statement:

- What is **the problem(s)** you want to help solve or the **goal(s)** you want to help reach?
- **Who** is impacted by the problem or will benefit most directly from the solution?
- How does your **research** address the societal goal(s)?



## ENGAGEMENT

**Who will you engage with** during this project? How do you plan to work together? In what ways will your partner(s) be active in the project?

Who are the people, communities, or organizations (your societal partners) who will be most impacted by your research?	
Do you already have a connection to the societal partners you hope to work with? If not, how will you establish a connection with them?	
Which impact pathway(s) is the best fit for meeting your societal partners' needs and building on your strengths and skills?	
At which points in the research or project will your societal partners be actively engaged?	
How will you budget for each engagement activity?	
What research review processes are required for this project?	
How will you allocate time in your project to complete all required reviews prior to starting partner engagement activities?
